HOW TO PREPARE

All SAILING PROGRAMS (except PeeWee Sailing) are for children age 8-17 years.

For your child's safety and comfort they must know how to swim. Children are required to bring their own quality Personal Flotation Device (PFD) to be worn at all times. It is recommended they bring a change of clothing and windbreaker or fleece, sunscreen, water bottle and hat.

Your child should bring a bag lunch from home or you may purchase lunch at our Boathouse Grill which includes burgers, sandwiches, soft drinks and snacks. Inquire at the Clubhouse front desk if you would like a temporary membership set up for this purpose.

The learning never stops. On inclement weather days, teachers refer to "chalk talk" where the mechanics of sailing are taught. Mock Sailboats are used for in-house demos. Various games and movies with a sailing theme are also utilized.

BEGINNER PROGRAM

Our beginner class is perfect for any age 8-17 to learn how to sail with no experience needed. Students will learn safety, sailing terminology as well as basic on the water skill, such as points of sail, tacking, jibing, and docking. Students will also begin to learn the fundamentals of racing towards the end of our lessons. On the water time is combined with classroom learning, as well as team building activities on land. Students should bring water and a snack. Students should also dress for the weather every day, including a rain jacket, swimsuit and a change of clothes.

INTERMEDIATE

Our intermediate class is split between three different boats: Optimis, 420's and Lasers. In this level, we prepare our students for our advanced racing class by building their knowledge of boat speed and racing tactics. Students must show proficiency in knowledge and skill before being passed into the advanced levels. These students will have the opportunity to start competing in local regattas during both sessions. Students should bring a lunch each day. Gear needs to include sailing gloves, warm technical wear (like Under Armor), dinghy boots and a spray top or other waterproof jacket.
